

KTR slams Telangana Governor's speech, calls it 'Congress press meet'

Talking to the media at the assembly premises, KTR accused the ruling Congress government, led by Chief Minister A. Revanah Reddy, of scripting the speech with "blatant lies and half-truths" to mask what he called 15 months of "failed governance."

KTR challenged Congress' claims about farm loan waivers, asserting that they had only covered 25-30 per-

cent of the state's farmers. He also accused the government of falsely claiming success with schemes like Rythu Bandhu and other welfare programs.

Further, KTR dismissed Congress' claims of securing Rs 1.79 lakh crore in investments at the World Economic Forum in Davos, calling it an "absolute lie." He alleged that previously announced projects had been relocated to other states due to Congress' inefficiency.

KTR warned that Telangana's people were increasingly aware of what he described as Congress's failures, predicting a public backlash soon.

CM's Public Program Achieves 66% Success Rate: Chinna Reddy

Hyderabad, March 12, TSIT: Dr G. Chinna Reddy, Vice Chairman of the State Planning Commission, said that if the problem goes to the roots, the problem will be fully result in the problem of solving the problem.
