CS orders for strict action against traffic disrup

hhattisgarh chief secretary, Amitabh Jain on Friday asked the officials to take strict action against individuals obstructing public roads for private celebrations including birthday parties, community feasts, and unauthorized pandals.

While addressing a high-level meeting held at the meeting hall in Chhattisgarh assembly premises, he said, roads are meant solely for transportation and any traffic disruption on roads will result in severe legal consequences against disruptors.

He directed concerned officials to enforce stringent legal measures such as imposing heavy penalties on violators and initiate an extensive public awareness campaign to curb such disruptions.

The chief secretary made it clear that any unauthorized occupation of roads will invite immediate action under antiencroachment act, motor vehicle act, municipal

act and also under relevant sections of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita 2023.

He directed authorities to seize vehicles used in such gatherings, impose substantial fines on organizers and initiate judicial proceedings against offenders. To ensure systematic enforcement of rules,

he also directed the police department to draft a standard operating procedure (SOP) for immediate intervention and strict monitoring.

Authorities warn against igniting forest fire for Mahua collection

In view of the rising heat, authorities in Kondagaon district on Friday advised the mahua collectors for not igniting the forest fire.

Usually, during March and April, Mahua flowers fall on grounds and the collectors handpick them. They often ignite controlled fire under trees in order to clear a patch of ground for collecting it easily, it may be noted. Meanwhile, the Keshkal Forest Division authorities said that when the fires spread uncontrollably, they disrupt the natural cycle and affect the quality of the wood.

In that course, small medicinal plants also get destroyed, and wildlife is also affected, the divisional authorities said. They said, a fire control cell had been established and people are being educated about fire safety even through street plays.
