

Siddaramaiah's video on altered MUDA documents triggers fresh complaint

Bengaluru: A video posted by Chief Minister Siddaramaiah on August 26, 2024, explaining the use of correction fluid on a controversial document, has sparked a fresh complaint against his wife, Parvathy BM, and Congress spokesperson M Lakshmana in connection with the MUDA scam.

The complaint, filed by activist Snehamayi Krishna, accuses them of fabricating documents and destroying original records to cover up illegal land acquisitions.

Krishna, who had earlier raised allegations against Siddaramaiah's family for illegally obtaining 14 plots from the Mysuru Urban Development



Authority (MUDA), lodged the complaint with Lakshmiপুরam Police Station on Wednesday. He alleges that the CM's August video and a letter released during a July 26 press conference are at the heart of a cover-up involving tampered documents. The letter, purportedly written by Parvathy to the MUDA commissioner on June 23, 2014, has been scrutinized by media outlets, who reported that correc-

tion fluid was used to obscure words on the second page, raising public suspicion. In his complaint, Krishna meticulously compared the signatures and markings on the original documents with those presented in the video, identifying nine discrepancies that suggest forgery. "The discrepancies include variations in signatures, the positioning of letters, and marks adjacent to the signatures, indicating that the original document was replaced with a fabricated one," Krishna stated. Further fueling suspicions, the complaint includes a video that allegedly shows Lakshmana discussing the use of correction fluid on the document.

Mangaluru: 5000 slow learners identified in SSLC in Dakshina Kannada

Mangaluru, Aug 30: Dakshina Kannada (DK) district ranked second in the SSLC examination for the 2023-24 academic year. The education department aims to secure the top spot in the 2024-25 academic year and has identified 4,742 students as slow learners. According to statistics from the school education and literacy department, there are 525 high schools in the district with 28,612 students enrolled in SSLC for the 2024-25 academic year. Among these, 4,742 are identified as slow learners, with most concentrated in the Bantwal and Mangaluru South zones.

The education department, in collaboration with

the Dakshina Kannada zilla panchayat, has launched 10 different programmes to support slow-learning students. These programmes will be implemented by the end of the academic year in February 2025, as per information provided by DDPI Venkatesha Subraya Patagara. School teachers will adopt slow-learning children and provide them with special guidance throughout the academic year. Another key initiative is to increase their attendance rate, as slow learners often tend to be absent from classes. The teachers who adopt these students will ensure regular attendance, contacting parents if necessary.

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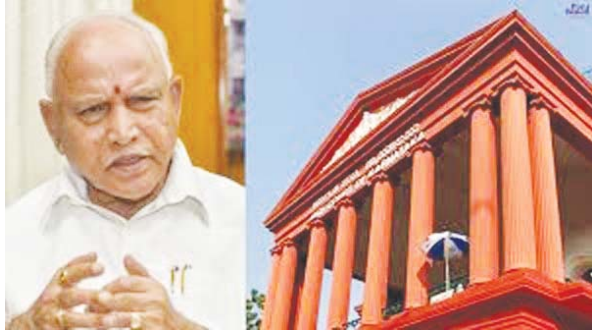
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Additionally, special classes tailored to slow-learning students have already begun, with schools offering one-hour sessions where subject teachers provide focused attention. Other initiatives include the use of e-learning tools, training for teachers in every subject by resource persons, and continuous supervision of educational reforms. Officials regularly visit high schools to monitor the progress of slow learners and provide guidance to teachers. Workshops are also held for slow-learning students to help them face examinations without fear and to boost their self-confidence, with support from counsellors and doctors.

HC to hear Yediyurappa POC SO case on Sep 5 as CID seeks adjournment



Bengaluru: The Karnataka High Court single bench on Friday adjourned to September 5 the hearing on the quash petition of former Chief Minister and BJP central parliamentary committee member B.S. Yediyurappa in connection with the Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO) case. The bench passed the order following the request by the senior public prosecutor Ashok Naik representing the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) seeking time to submit documents in the case. The bench has also continued the interim order directing the police not to initiate action against Yediyurappa. C.V. Nagesh, senior counsel representing

Yediyurappa submitted to the court that, every day one or the other ministers of the Congress government are issuing comments about sending Yediyurappa to jail. They claim that they will get the interim stay vacated and get him arrested. However, now they are demanding for adjournment of the case, he chided.

Counsel Nagesh further stated that the ministers said that Yediyurappa should surrender before the police in the case and he will be sent to the prison. "I challenge the other party to place the arguments now. If it is in the fate of my client to go to prison, let him land in prison," he submitted. Replying to it, SPP Ashok Naik maintained that, "we

are ready for arguments in the case." Earlier, Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah had said that Yediyurappa should retire from public life after being charged in the POCSO Act case at the age of 82 years.

He had said this while hitting out at the BJP for seeking his resignation over alleged irregularities in the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) and allegations of corruption by the opposition parties.

"Yediyurappa has been charged in a POCSO case and it is due to the mercy of the court that he has not been sent to jail as bail cannot be given in these cases. What morality does Yediyurappa have, if he is caught in a POCSO case at this age? The media won't show much of it," the CM had said. "Yediyurappa should retire from public life. At the age of 82, he has misbehaved with a girl and a POCSO case has been lodged against him and the police have submitted a charge sheet, what moral right does he have to speak against me?"

Will be happy if promoted, says HM Parameshwara amid rumours of CM change

Bengaluru, Aug 30: Karnataka Home Minister G. Parameshwara said on Friday that he will be happy if he is promoted by the Congress party. The statement assumes importance in the backdrop of rumours circulated that Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, facing the allegations on the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) case, may be replaced. When asked about Minister for Cooperation K.N. Rajanna's statement that he will be happy if Parameshwara is promoted by the party, he stated that he will also be happy in that case. CM Siddaramaiah's camp had batted for a Dalit CM in case of his replacement earlier. Parameshwara had also stated that he is not a sage for not aspiring to become the CM.

Parameshwara is the senior-most leader hailing from the Dalit community after AICC President Mallikarjun Kharge from the state. He is also a resourceful and experienced leader. Talking about Raj Bhavan Chalo agitation on Saturday, he stated, "We had tenta-



tively stated that all MLAs, MLCs and MPs will take up Raj Bhavan Chalo protest march and hand over the representation to the Governor. The cabinet had taken a decision explaining to the Governor that issuing of show-cause notice to CM Siddaramaiah was wrong. The government has the power to advise the Governor and we have sent a submission in this regard. It is not just a letter, all evidence is mentioned and sent. He has not obliged to it and the matter

has been moved to the court." "The arguments are placed and they will continue tomorrow. We have to see what would be the final decision in this regard. It is also our duty to inform the Governor. The MUDA case has taken a political twist, no matter what we talk about the court and other things, it has taken a political colour. Hence, our cadres will stage a protest against the Governor," he further said.

"We are thinking of staging protests in all divisions. Along with it, the legal battle would continue and also submit representation to the Governor. If any of these won't yield any results, we are contemplating meeting the President," he maintained.

Parameshwara further stated, "While placing arguments, senior counsel Abhishek Manu Singhvi

has mentioned pending cases against Union Minister H.D. Kumaraswamy, former BJP ministers Shashikala Jolle and Murugesu Nirani. For years, permission is not granted for prosecution against them, why in the case of CM Siddaramaiah, the decision is made in haste? We will mention this when we meet the Governor and the President of India."

"Following the development of luxury treatment accorded to Darshan, we have heightened the security and monitoring in prisons. It is not possible for anyone now to do as they want," he maintained.

On the PSI recruitment exam and the UPSC Mains exam falling on the same day (Sept 22), Home Minister Parameshwara said that information will be obtained from the concerned authorities. He said, "We announced the PSI exam date before the UPSC. If there is a possibility of postponement and if there are more requests, it can be considered. This matter will be reviewed and discussed with the officials."
